

Proposed Amendments to By Laws Tri-Cities Metallic Silhouette Association

Amendment 1:

Article III new Section 7: Law Enforcement Members: Active duty, reserve and retired law enforcement officers, who have fulfilled all other requirements for regular members, shall be offered membership in the association at an annual membership fee as outlined in the TCMSA policy book. Law enforcement members shall not have voting privileges.

Amendment 2:

Article III Section 1 amended as follows: Regular members: Any citizen of the United States eighteen (18) years or older, who can legally own a firearm, may become a member of this organization after filling out a membership form and payment of the usual dues and initiation fees.

Article VI Section 4 amended as follows: Members of the Board must have at least three (3) years membership in the club as Regular Members in good standing, have been actively involved in organized shooting, and be members of the National Rifle Association.

Article VIII Section 1 amended as follows: The officers of the club shall consist of: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Officers must be Regular Members in good standing and be members of the National Rifle Association. They shall be elected by a majority vote of Regular Members in good standing present at the Annual Meeting. The term of office for each of these positions is one (1) year or until their successor is elected at the next Annual Meeting.

Amendment 3:

Article VII Section 7 amended as follows: Any changes to the range facility shall be approved by the board.

Amendment 4:

Article XIII Section 1 amended as follows: Any club member may suggest, in writing, by-law changes prior to the 1st of September or the 1st of March of each year to the club secretary. The club secretary shall enter the suggestion into the official records and pass the suggestion to the Board of Directors.

Section 3 amended as follows: If the proposed amendment is approved by the Board, the Board shall write the proposed amendment language, return it to the club secretary by the 15th of November or the 15th of May, whichever comes first. The secretary shall then mail a copy to members in good standing no later than the 1st of December or the 1st of June, whichever comes first. The proposed amendment

shall be voted on at the next annual meeting or at a special meeting held on the date of the regular meeting in July, whichever comes first.

Amendment 5:

Honorary Members: Any person, business, or organization that shows exemplary support for the club. Honorary members must be approved by the membership annually.
