Applications can be handled at our regular meetings or by mail by sending a signed application, a check, and a photocopy of your <u>current NRA membership card or</u> <u>mailing label</u> from your monthly NRA magazine to: TCMSA, P.O. Box 4587. Pasco, WA. 99302-4587. *Dues are \$60.00 for new (first-time) members and \$50 for renewals, subject to participation in a work party during the membership year (March to March). If you participated in a work party during the membership year, there will be a \$25.00 reduction. (\$25.00 Total). Proof of current NRA membership is required of all members; your check <u>will be returned</u> if your active membership in the NRA cannot be verified. Memberships renewed between December 1, 2004 and March 31, 2005 will be honored through March 31, 2006. Please note that members that do not renew prior to Apr 1, 2005 will not be given the new combination. Members not renewing prior to Dec 2005 will be required to re-apply for membership (\$60.00) For 2006 renewals please hold until after the January meeting. The 2006 combination will not be determined until Mid January.*
