If you participated in a work party during the membership year, there will be a \$25.00 reduction. (**\$25.00 Total**). Proof of current NRA membership is required of all members; your check <u>will be returned</u> if your active membership in the NRA cannot be verified. Memberships renewed between December 1, 2006 and March 31, 2007 will be honored through March 31, 2008. Please note that members that do not renew prior to Apr 1, 2006 will not be given the new combination. Members not renewing prior to Dec 2006 will be required to re-apply for membership (\$60.00). <u>Note that new members may join the club</u> but will not be given range access until they complete orientation
