Board of Directors / Officers Reports

Still working to secure a long term lease, there is also an ongoing effort to secure an additional range site.

Attorney Bill Davis is drafting a new lease agreement for the existing range, and the board will be meeting to review a memorandum of understanding (MOA) for a potential lease on the Cowell property near Eureka. In previous discussions, Mr. Cowell indicated that he was not in favor of adding a shotgun range. Wally Ruff met with the Walla Walla Sheriff's department in a separate meeting; they indicated a willingness to work with the TCMSA toward obtaining a range, as the department is also looking for a suitable place to practice.
