Safety Rules: When the range is cold (lights flashing) it applies to the pistol portion and the shotgun portion as well as the bench positions. No one should handle firearms when the range is in the cold condition.

Range safety and rule enforcement were the topics of discussion during the Board meeting. Gate locks are being destroyed. The Safety Committee has been charged with the task of range monitoring and rule enforcement. The Board recommends that members sign in and out as they use the range. A book will be provided near the Match Directors shack. The Board also recommends the use of nametags by members, possibly photo ID style.

At present, over 80% of our membership receives a mailed newsletter, costing the club around \$140 per month and about 6 hours to prep and send out the newsletter.

Membership & Renewals: In order to reduce delays at the meeting you can renew by mail.

Applications can be handled at our regular meetings or by mail by sending a signed application, a check, and a photocopy of your current NRA membership card or mailing label from your monthly NRA magazine to: TCMSA, P.O. Box 4587. Pasco, WA. 99302-4587. Dues are \$60.00 for new (first-time) members and \$50 for renewals, subject to participation in a work party during the membership year (March to March). If you participated in a work party during the membership year, there will be a \$25.00 reduction. (\$25.00 Total). Proof of current NRA membership is required of all members; your check will be returned if your active membership in the NRA cannot be verified. Memberships renewed between December 1, 2007 and March 31, 2008 will be honored through March 31, 2009. Please note that members that do not renew prior to Apr 1, 2007 will not be given the new combination. Members not renewing prior to Dec 2007 will be required to re-apply for membership (\$60.00). Note that new members may join the club but will not be given range access until they complete orientation
