Announcements

- **Do Not** give out the gate combination to friends or relatives and do not "short lock" the gate lock. **You** are responsible for safety and cleanliness at the range. **Read and follow the rules.** The continuation of our ability to have a place to shoot depends on it.
- > If you are the last person to leave the range, make sure that the power to the safety light system is turned off and the range flag is down and stored.
- > The clay pigeon throwers *must* be cocked *counterclockwise* only. Otherwise damage will occur.
- > Please pull worn /shot up target stands and replace them as needed. New stands are stored in the trailer.
- Lee Haberling says if you renew your NRA membership thru him for \$25.00, \$5.00 will go to the club.
- Members at the Range that witness an incident must fill out an Incident Report to make the "self policing system work.
- **Be sure unfired(dud) ammo in the proper container(dud box) and not in the garbage can.**

Membership & Renewals: In order to reduce delays at the meeting you can renew by mail.

Applications can be handled at our regular meetings or by mail by sending a signed application, a check, and a photocopy of your current NRA membership card or mailing labe! from your monthly NRA magazine to: TCMSA, P.O. Box 4587. Pasco, WA. 99302-4587. Dues are \$60.00 for new (first-time) members and \$50 for renewals, subject to participation in a work party during the membership year (March to March). If you participated in a work party during the membership year, there will be a \$25.00 reduction. (\$25.00 Total). Proof of current NRA membership is required of all members; your check will be returned if your active membership in the NRA cannot be verified. Memberships renewed between December 1, 2008 and March 31, 2009 will be honored through March 31, 2010. Please note members that do not renew prior to Apr 1, 2009 will not be given the new combination. Members not renewing prior to Dec 2009 will be required to re-apply for membership (\$60.00). Note that new members may join the club but will not be given range access until they complete orientation
