Note: TCMSA is NRA affiliated, you must be a member of the NRA to be a TCMSA member

- > Do Not give out the gate combination to friends or relatives and do not "short lock" the gate lock. You are responsible for safety and cleanliness at the range. **Read and follow the rules.** The continuation of our ability to have a place to shoot depends on it.
- There are now two gongs at 100vds and two at 200vds. Please no steel rounds.
- The shooting sports and alcohol do not mix. Please do not bring alcohol to the Range.  $\triangleright$
- Use proper targets that incorporate the berms. Bottles and cans do not qualify. The club is looking into reactive  $\triangleright$ targets. Please bare with us.
- $\geq$ Be sure unfired (dud) ammo is put in the proper container (dud box) and not in the garbage can.

Safety Rules: Remember!! DO NOT HANDLE FIREARMS when the range is in the cold condition and people are down range. A Cold Range condition is inclusive of all sections of the range, i.e., pistol, High-Power, shotgun, bench.
